New Translation of the Roman Missal

During the month of November we will continue to gradually introduce the new recommended changes in the Mass.

EUCCHARISTIC ACCLAMATION:

SAVE US, SAVIOUR OF THE WORLD, FOR BY YOUR CROSS AND RESURRECTION YOU HAVE SET US FREE.

Questions People Ask:

Q. Are the souls in purgatory in terrible suffering?

A. Our Catholic Catechism is very consoling on this point. 'All who die in God's grace and friendship but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven' (Catechism, 1030). These blessed people know they are saved. They are very close to God. So they must be very happy, yet suffering the pain of recognising how poorly they have appreciated God's love and used their God-given talents. I think it is like the child who has been bold but now cuddles up in the parent's loving arms, crying in the recognition of how wrong he/she had been. The suffering of purgatory is the result of knowing how much we have been loved and how poor was our response to that love.

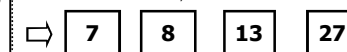
