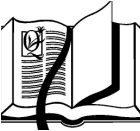

## New Translation of the Roman Missal

### What is the Roman Missal?

The term "Missal" refers to the book that contains all the prayers and instructions for the celebration of the Mass. The scripture readings used at Mass are also part of the Missal but are published separately in the "Lectioary." The Missal is first written in Latin and this Latin text is then

translated into the particular language of the people. In this way, while the Mass may be celebrated in many languages across the Roman Catholic world, it is the same core Latin text that is being prayed by the Church. In Ireland we have been using our current Missal since St. Patrick's Day 1975. A new edition, the Third Edition of the Roman Missal, is coming into use in Ireland and in other English speaking countries in Autumn 2011.

From early September onwards we will begin to gradually introduce the changes in the celebration of Mass in the parish.
