New Translation of the Roman Missal



Next weekend at our parish Masses we mark a significant step in the journey towards full use of the new edition of the Roman Missal. The full implementation of the New Missal will not take place until the First Sunday of Advent—27th November.

- From next weekend we will begin to use the new translation of some of the people's responses for use during Mass.
- During the weekends of September we will introduce the changes to the Mass from the beginning up until the end of the Gospel along with introducing one of the new acclamations for the Eucharistic prayer.
- Special cards will be available in the seats from next weekend to help us adapt to the changes involved.
- Along with the new translation in the Mass texts themselves we will be introducing the new recommended posture positions (*standing/ kneeling/ sitting*) for various parts of the Mass.
- A leaflet—"Introducing the New Missal—Questions and Answers"—is available in the church this weekend to assist with our understanding of the new changes being introduced.

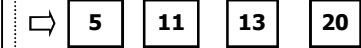
