Q. Why is the Rosary so highly regarded?

A. The rosary is a way of asking Mary to lead us to her Son, Jesus Christ, as she did at Cana. Each decade recalls an event from - the early life of Jesus (*the Joyful mysteries*), the light of his ministry (*the Luminous mysteries*), his passion (*the Sorrowful mysteries*), or his glorification (*the Glorious mysteries*). We meditate on these events so as to imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise. It is Jesus who is at the centre of the Rosary, just as the centre of the Hail Mary is the name of Jesus. 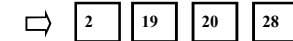
