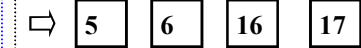

## Second Collection—Church Repair Fund

Our thanks to all who assist with their financial contributions towards the upkeep and renewal of the fabric of our two Church buildings in the parish. Parishioners wishing to include their contribution for the Second Collection for Repairs of Church Buildings may do so in their contribution in the weekly envelope—a portion of their yearly contribution will assist with the repairs. In the past year 20% of the donations received in the weekly envelope collection went to the Church Repair Fund.

In 2010 over €50,000 was spent in renovation and repair work to our churches. Among the works completed were the following:

**KILKEE Church:** Installation of new banners and lighting in sanctuary area; repair of flat roofs;

**LISDEEN Church:** Repair to heating; new tiling at front entrance; continuation of installation of new windows.

We are very grateful to all of you for your continued support which enables the parish to carry out these works.
