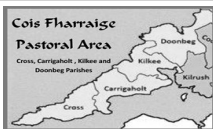

Kilkee Church Roofs Repair



The major work of replacing the roof at Kilkee Church and doing essential repairs to the concrete & steel at the upper roof levels is now completed. We are grateful to all who supported our special fund for this work over the years through the Second Basket Collection at weekend Masses in Kilkee church and through other generous donations to this special fund. Through your generosity the cost of the entire new roof has been covered. However, the extra work of repair to the concrete and steel which we had not anticipated, leaves us with a new debt in the region of €80,000.

Celebration of Sacraments for our children:
The celebration of the Sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation were to have taken place during last school term but had to be postponed because of the pandemic restrictions at that time. We are now planning to hold these important celebrations over the coming weeks.

- The celebration of Confirmation and First Holy Communion will necessitate that for the weekends of 12th/13th & 19th/20th September any Funeral arrangements or Baptisms will be adjusted around the programme.
- Communication with the families involved in the celebration of the Sacraments will take place during the coming weeks outlining the guidelines involved with these celebrations.
- Current guidelines from the government and the diocese necessitate that numbers attending these special ceremonies be limited.
