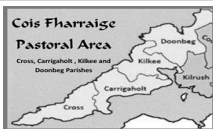

You can return the completed list by delivering it to my own house or to the special boxes in Lisdeen or Kilkee church during the periods when the churches are open for private prayer or to Keane's at Lisdeen.

The three parish Masses on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup>, Friday 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> November will be Masses celebrated for the deceased of the past year.

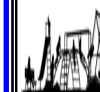
**Activities for people over 55 years old in West Clare**
