In conclusion we want to thank you all most sincerely for your loyal support in the past. Wishing you all a Very Happy Christmas and Safe New Year.

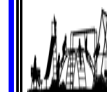
Youth Takeover of Beyond Belief

Due to limited capacity in accordance with Government guidelines and to allow as many households from the parish to be represented in the Church at one of our Christmas Masses over this period, we ask that people would choose a Mass that suits them over the period.

In order to safely accommodate those wishing to attend our Church for Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day we are implementing a **TICKET system for the 3 Masses over these 2 days.**

Two tickets will be allocated to each successful applicant in the system and each household can only qualify for one allocation across the 3 Masses.

Application forms are only available in Kilkee and Lisdeen Churches.

The Application Form must be completed in full and placed in the Secure Donation Box at the entrance/exit to the church .

Applications close at 7.30 p.m. on Wednesday 16th December
