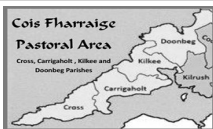

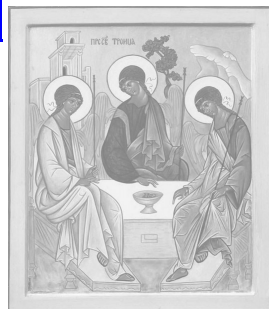

Blessed Trinity



The beautiful Russian icon of the Blessed Trinity by Andrei Rublev depicts the three persons of the Trinity sitting at a table.

A dish of food lies on the table at the front of which there is a vacant place. This is intended to convey openness, hospitality and welcome to the stranger and the outsider.

The vacant place is meant for each of us, and for all the human family. It signifies God's invitation to us to share in the life of the Trinity.

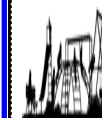
