- The number attending funeral services and weddings is capped at 50 people regardless of the size of the church.

- Please note the change of time to 7.30 p.m. for the Wednesday and Friday evening Masses. The Wednesday evening Mass will be celebrated in Lisdeen Church and the Friday evening and Sunday morning Masses will be celebrated in Kilkee Church .
- We are grateful for the cooperation and assistance of our stewards and personnel in enabling us to re-open our churches for public worship.
