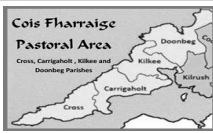

### “Using many parables, he spoke to them .....”

Parables were a teaching technique used by Jesus as a way to lead people into a new way of listening. They were not instructions to provide information and they were not fables with fixed conclusions.

Parables were and are invitations to pray and to listen in a radical way! The point of the parable was to subvert and invert our assumptions about people, the world, and God.

God’s parable-word to us is like a seed that drifts onto soil it did not choose. God’s word is like a seed that is received in an unexpected soil. God’s mustard seed of love is like a life that blossoms in surprising ways – beyond our imagining.
