

Synodal Process

In these days the Catholic Church throughout the world and in Ireland is beginning a series of conversations about what God wants of his people at this time. These conversations are often referred to as a Synodal Process. "Synodal" come from a Greek word which means "walking together". This Sunday, 17th October, we mark the opening of this Synodal Process entitled, "For a Synodal Church: communion, participation and mission". This synodal process coincides with the start of the two year Synodal Pathway for the Catholic Church in Ireland which will lead, in time, to a National Synodal Assembly in Ireland.


