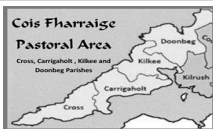

2nd Sunday in Advent

Advent is the time when we are reminded that we have to wait for God.
We cannot grasp God, we cannot possess God, we cannot see God; we can only wait for God to let himself be known.

And when we wait for God we confess our own incompleteness, we acknowledge that there is always more to God than what we know.

When we wait for God, our waiting is a prayer—like that of Mary : we testify to our own poverty and to God's greatness.
