The Psalmist prays, "Hear my prayer, O Lord, and give ear to mu cru...For I am your guest, a traveller passing

Once our ancestors had received land, God reminded them: "...the land is mine; with me you are but aliens and tenants" (Lev 25:23). No matter what appears to be ours, what we claim to possess, all is a gift. We are God's guests.

On life's challenging journey, we need companions. God is in the fellow strangers on the road. Who is with you on the road? God invites them and you to a banquet where there is a place for everyone at the table. Will you exclude or welcome? God has welcomed us, and we in turn welcome others.

Hospitality is not restricted to place, person, or provision. Each of us can offer welcome. We can do it on the street, in a coffee shop, in an apartment, or in a house. We do it with whatever we have, wherever we are. Hospitality becomes healing when I am so present to another that they are able to be fully themselves. Who are you? How are you? Hospitality means my attentive response to you, making space for you to show up as you are.

Henri Nouwen describes hospitality as "the creation of a free space where the stranger can enter and become a friend instead of an enemy. Hospitality is not to change people, but to offer them space where change can take place."
