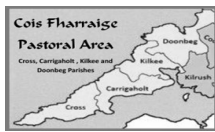

## Reflection.....

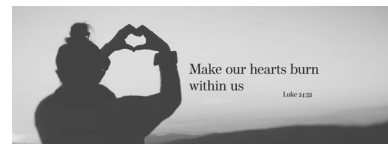
O Great Spirit, whose voice I hear in the winds,

my spirit may come to you without shame.

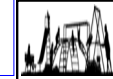
