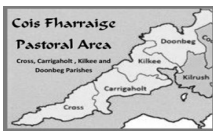


Mary's Meals
