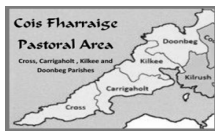

Seeds of Prayer....

Jesus several times used the image of seeds to illustrate his
teaching that small things have great potential, including small
seeds of faith. Imagine, then, that in your time of intercession
you are planting seeds of prayer in the garden of God's love
laid out before you...

First of all, plant seeds of faith for your family and close
friends. These are the ones you care deeply about, knowing them well, with
all their beauty and their sharp edges. You know their needs, and their
challenges. Plant those seeds of prayer for them now, and trust God to bring
about the growth...

Now plant some seeds of prayer for people you know less well but who are
part of the tapestry of your life. They may be neighbours, colleagues, people
you see and meet. See who comes to mind. Plant seeds of prayer for whom
God lays in your heart at this time...

Now plant some seeds of prayer for people who are in the public eye....people
in the news...leaders, sports men and women...celebrities with huge
temptations to believe their own publicity. Who catches your eye? Who might
be in particular need of support and wisdom at present?

Further away in the garden of God's love, seeds of prayer are needed for
places and nations collapsing under the pressures of war, famine or other
disasters. Plant those seeds deep and water them well, and be prepared to
return often to care for the fragile early growth...

You have seeds left over. Cast them wide over the whole garden, for we have a
world deeply in need of prayer at all points and all times. Cast those seeds
with love and joy, for this is our privilege, to work with God to sustain and
heal the world in anticipation of a new creation promised by the Lord's
Resurrection.
