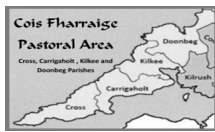

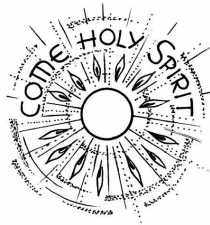
### Reflection
