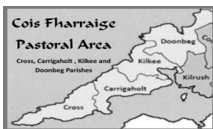

This weekend we welcome Bishop Fintan as he joins us to
celebrate the 110'clock Mass in Kilkee on Sunday to mark the 60
years of our two parish churches in Lisdeen and Kilkee.

- We give thanks for the dedication and service of the previous
generation who undertook the major task of planning and
construction of our present day parish churches.
- Since the dedication of the Churches 60 years ago there have been
over 1,800 Baptisms and 497 couples have been married in the
churches. The parish has celebrated the funeral rites for over
1,700 parishioners during the 60 year period.
- In a period that has seen so much change in our world, our society
and our understanding of ourselves, both churches have remained
as a constant reminder of the comfort and protection of God on all
our journeys. They are sacred places for parishioners and visitors
alike to connect with the peace and assurance that we journey as
people of faith toward the promised Kingdom of God. We pray
that those who began the good work in us and for us are at rest
with Mary and all the saints.
