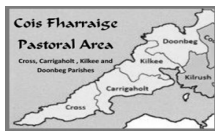

## Getting Married

Couples intending to be married in the Catholic Church should be aware of both Civil and Church requirements.



As part of the Civil requirements couples need to notify the Civil Registrar of their intended marriage at least 3 calendar months in advance.

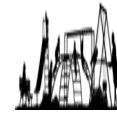
