APPEAL TO FARMERS: RECORDS FOR NESTING CHOUGH Clare County Council's Biodiversity Officer and BirdWatch Ireland are carrying out field surveys (April to June) for nesting Chough along a 30km stretch of coastline extending from Kilkee to Loop Head. We are appealing to all farmers within 1km of the coastline for any records they may have of Chough nest sites. This coastal bird species is of conservation importance and looks like a crow. However, Chough have a red bill and red legs and an unmistakable call. Chough can nest on coastal cliffs in caves or in cattle sheds, haybarns or derelict cottages. Many farmers along the coast are familiar with this bird and we are appealing for their help in surveying this area for records of breeding/nesting Chough.
