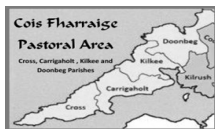

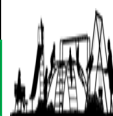


This weekend the June Priests Collection is being taken up. Special envelopes for your donation are available at the doors. Thank you for your support.
