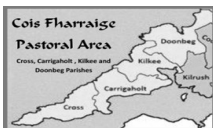

### A Reflection...

In Luke's Gospel a key part of Jesus' ministry is table fellowship.

More than in any of the other Gospels, Luke shows Jesus eating and drinking at table.

Jesus frequently used the image of a great banquet to explain God's vision for our world. The feast that is described here emphasises hospitality to strangers, and not just any strangers. Jesus speaks of a preferential option for the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind. They are outsiders, because of their circumstances. The parable in today's Gospel urges us to be open to real people and their very real situations.

All of our celebrations of Mass (the Eucharist) are a foretaste of the Banquet we are invited to in God's Kingdom. As we are nourished by the Lord's presence in our reception of the Eucharist may we respond in our welcome and care for others.

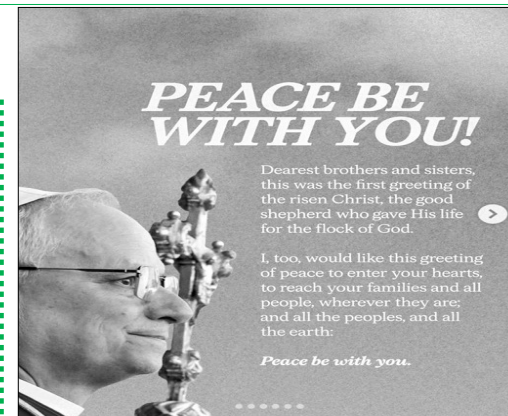
### Prayer for Peace in our World
