Prayer for Peace in our World

### Reflection....

Each year, the Season of Creation proposes a theme to focus on. This year's theme is "Peace with Creation", inspired by Isaiah 32:14-18: "My people will abide in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places." There's a flourishing promised in the scripture here, a

restoration of right relationships, and this brings deep peace, the kind of peace Jesus offers to his disciples after the resurrection, the kind of peace Pope Leo talks about. A peace that is not just the absence of war and conflict, but a peace that goes deeper to the core of creation, that recognizes the innate dignity of all things held in the delicate ecosystem of life. When our eyes are open to the gifts and abundance of life within our planet, when we contemplate creation and the gifts of the creator visible and invisible around us (like the atoms in a grain of sand, or particles in droplets of rain), we get a sense of ourselves within a myriad of fascinating relationships and see how everything is connected. "Nature cannot be regarded as something separate from ourselves or as a mere setting in which we live," Pope Francis wrote in Laudato Si'. "We are part of nature." (Laudato Si', 139).
