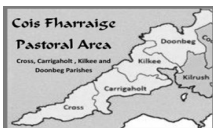

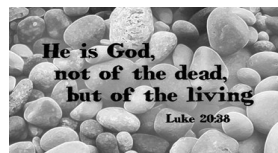
In Your light may they see light—and the stirrings of hope. God of November, Lord of the year, lead us through this month with faith, hope and love.

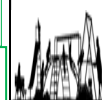

Missionvale Ireland is a charity that supports the Missionvale Care Centre in Port Elizabeth, founded by Sr. Ethel Normoyle, Lisseycasey. Sr. Ethel began her work in the 1980s, caring for the people of the Missionvale township, living in extreme poverty. The centre provides essential services including, food, education, healthcare, and skills training to empower the local community. Eve, Nathan and Ms Gilmore will be volunteering with the local community in the Missionvale Care Centre, in various areas including crafting, youth development, home visits, clinic work, maintenance, nutrition, gardening, and many more. Missionvale Ireland raises funds and awareness to sustain and expand the programmes founded and set up by Sr Ethel, ensuring long-term support for those in need. Sr. Ethel's lifelong mission has inspired countless volunteers and donors, embodying compassion, dignity and above all love and hope for vulnerable communities. Eve, Nathan and Ms Gilmore are really looking forward to this opportunity to help others in need. Next Sunday at Kilkee Mass we will have an opportunity to hear about this project.
