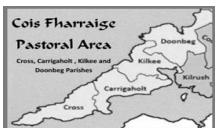

Kilkee Church Repairs

Over the coming months we plan to continue with essential repair and maintenance work on our church building. Last Summer we carried out work on the repair of the steel and concrete pillars supporting the large stained glass window at the front of the church and the painting of the front elevation of the church. We have been assisted in this repair work by a grant from the Albert Gubay charitable foundation. Over the coming weeks we will be installing a new lighting system at the front car park.
