### The Grandeur of Humanity

Pope Leo XIV just released his first encyclical – and it may be the most important Church document of our lifetime. Called *Magnifica Humanitas*, -

(*The Grandeur of Humanity*) it covers artificial intelligence, human dignity, children's phones, autonomous weapons, doomscrolling, the mystery of

the human soul, and why no machine will ever have the final word on what it means to be a person made in the image of God.

*Brief Quotes from the document:*

- “Never has humanity had such power over itself.” (par. 4)
- “In practice, however, technology is never neutral, because it takes on the characteristics of those who devise, finance, regulate and use it. Therefore, the primary choice is not between a ‘yes’ or ‘no’ to technology, but rather ..... between a power that claims to dominate the heavens and a people who work together in the presence of God to rebuild the walls of fraternal coexistence.” (par. 9)
- “In the era of artificial intelligence, when human dignity is threatened by new forms of dehumanization, ours is the pressing duty to remain profoundly human. We must lovingly safeguard the grandeur of humanity bestowed upon us and revealed in its fullness in Christ, the splendour of which no machine can ever replace.” (par. 15)
