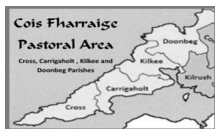

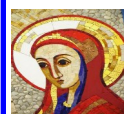

Doonbeg Heritage week events

Event 1: Story of the Doonbeg Church's stained-glass windows. This talk will share details of the stained glass created by Murphy Devitt Studio and the history of the Haugh memorial window from the old Doonbeg church created by the famous Harry Clarke studio. It will be hosted by John Glynn author of Clare's stained-glass archive online. Starts at 11.25am until 12 noon on 15th August. Meet in the church. **Event 2:** Visit to Baltard Bay & Castle. This talk will cover the history of the Cliffs of Baltard and surrounding area. Followed by a walk to the castle yard to see the ruins of Napoleonic Signal Tower.
